Prof. Debasis Mishra is a faculty at the Indian Statistical Institute, Delhi. He obtained his Ph.D. degree in Industrial Engineering from University of Wisconsin, Madison. He teaches Game theory and Mechanism design. His research areas include theory of auctions and mechanism design, social choice theory, game theory. He was awarded the Social Choice and Welfare Prize in 2018.



Prof. Abhiroop Mukhopadhyay is a faculty member at the Indian Statistical Institute, Delhi. He obtained his Ph.D. degree in Economics from The Pennsylvania State University. He teaches Introductory and Advanced Econometrics, Structural Estimation Methods in Empirical Industrial Organization. His research areas include Development Economics, Education, Labor, Applied Econometrics. He has been the recipient of several national and international research grants.



Dr. Mausumi Das is a faculty member at the Delhi School of Economics. She obtained her Ph.D. degree in Economics from Jawaharlal Nehru University. She teaches Growth Theory, Macroeconomics and Mathematical Economics. Her research areas include Growth and Development; Macroeconomics; Development Macroeconomics.
